## **Food Waste**

Don't use a garbage disposal - they add non-dissolving solids, grease and oils into a septic system.

## **Cleaning Products**

Household cleaning products will kill the bacteria that break down solids & could damage tank walls.

## **Tank Additives**

These products add extra solids to a system and the jury is out on whether they offer any benefits.

## **Non-Flushables**

Don't flush wet wipes, Kleenex, paper towels, tampons, cotton swabs, diapers or dental floss.

## **Prescriptions**

Medications can contaminate liquid waste, seep into soil and pollute nearby water sources.

## **Extra Water**

Use low-flow toilets & fix leaky faucets since too much water can cause septic system failure.

Keeping harmful substances out of your septic system will prevent problems before they start.
